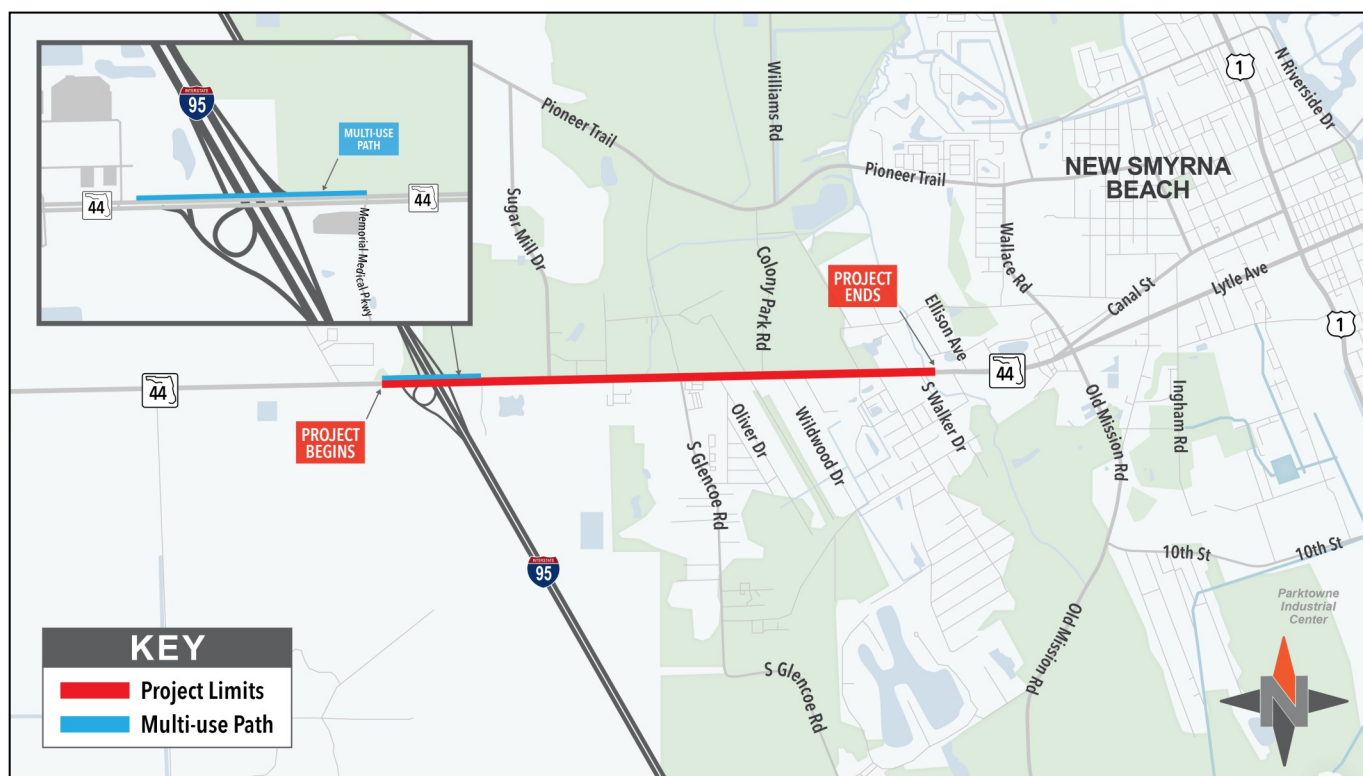


Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to make improvements along State Road (S.R.) 44 from west of Interstate 95 (I-95) to east of South Walker Drive in New Smyrna Beach.

This project will resurface the corridor, make minor drainage improvements and upgrade sidewalk curb ramps, as needed, to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards. The FDOT also plans lighting and signalization improvements at the I-95, Colony Park Road, and South Glencoe Road intersections.

In addition, the Volusia-Flagler Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) will fund the construction of a new multi-use path near the I-95 interchange.
