Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to resurface State Road (S.R.) 471 from south of the Little Withlacoochee River to S.R. 50 in Sumter County. The purpose of this project is to replace the asphalt to maintain a safe and reliable driving surface and extend the service life of the roadway.

In addition, FDOT will install audible vibratory pavement markings along the shoulders within the project limits. These pavement markings help reduce lane departure crashes by alerting drivers if their vehicle drifts outside the travel lane.
