Project Description

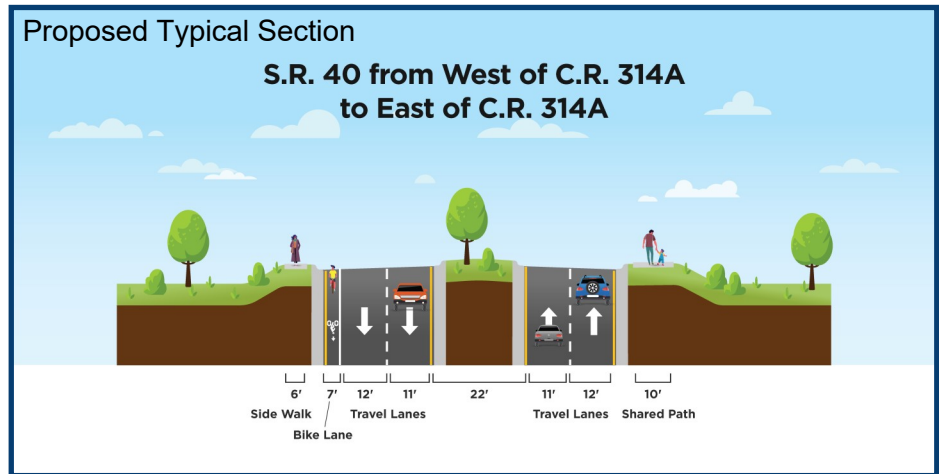
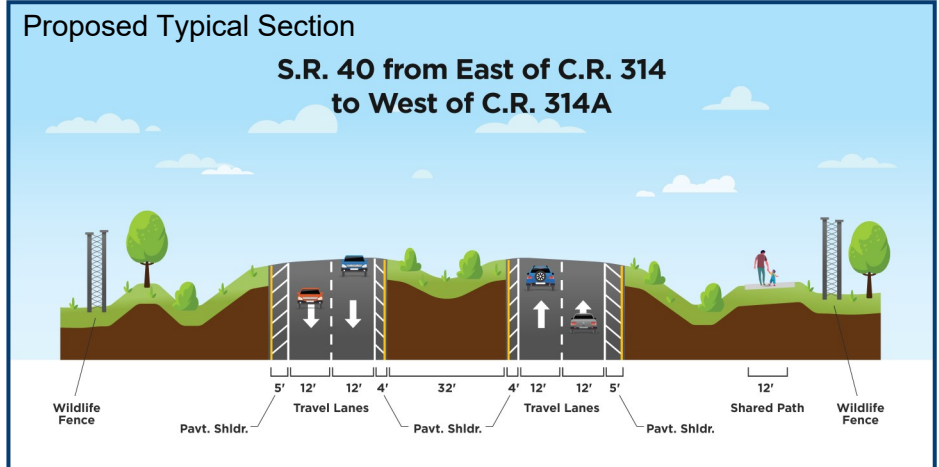
The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing to widen State Road (S.R.) 40 from east of County Road (C.R.) 314 to east of C.R. 314A.

The project proposes widening the road west of C.R. 314A to include two 12-foot-wide travel lanes in each direction with 5-foot-wide shoulders and separated by a 40-foot-wide grassed median. A 12-foot-wide shared-use path will be provided along the eastbound side of S.R. 40.

From C.R. 314A to just east of the project, one 12-foot-wide lane and one 11-foot-wide lane will be included in each direction with a 7-foot-wide bike lane in the westbound direction and a 10-foot-wide shared use path along the eastbound side.

Additionally, multiple wildlife crossings of various types and sizes will also be provided throughout the corridor.

This project is not currently funded for construction.
