S.R. 60 PD&E Study from Prairie Lake Road to Florida's Turnpike

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

FINANCIAL PROJECT IDENTIFICATION (FPID) NUMBER: 452574-1 | MAY 2025

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is conducting a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study for State Road (S.R.) 60 from Prairie Lake Road to Florida's Turnpike in Osceola County, a distance of approximately 19.3 miles. This east-west corridor serves as a key link to major facilities, such as Interstate 75 (I-75) in Tampa to I-95 in Vero Beach. This roadway plays an essential role in regional connectivity, linking communities and colleges, while facilitating freight movement that supports the area's economic activity.

STUDY GOALS

The purpose of this project is to address future travel demand and improve safety. The improvements being evaluated by this PD&E Study include widening the existing roadway from two to four lanes, strengthening east-west regional connectivity across Polk, Osceola, and Indian River counties, and enhancing overall safety and operation of S.R. 60.

Begin Study: December 2024

Kickoff Newsletter: May 2025

Public Hearing: October 2025

Anticipated Study Completion: Spring 2026

BACKGROUND

Despite previous safety improvements along this segment of S.R. 60, further enhancements are needed to address increasing transportation demand and continue improving safety. Between 2018 and 2022, this stretch of roadway experienced 308 total crashes and 12 fatalities—a rate higher than the statewide average for similar facilities. FDOT is committed to improving the safety of this vital stretch of S.R. 60.
