State Road A1A Improvements, Brevard County

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding project plans on State Road (S.R.) A1A from south of International Drive to Long Point Road (FPID No.: 430202-5) and on S.R. A1A from Long Point Road to George King Boulevard (FPID No.: 430202-8) on Tuesday, October 5, at 6 p.m. The purpose of these projects is to improve mobility and promote safety for drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists. Improvements proposed as part of the 430202-5 project include realigning International Drive to connect S.R. A1A at North Atlantic Avenue and constructing a roundabout at the new intersection. The 430202-8 project will reconstruct the corridor, which would include adding a raised median. FDOT is offering multiple ways to participate in the same live meeting.
