

# ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS

S.R. 527 (Orange Avenue) at S.R. 438 (Princeton Street)

## Orange County

### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will improve the safety, mobility, and efficiency at the intersection of S.R. 527 (Orange Avenue) and S.R. 438 (Princeton Street). Features of this project include sidewalk additions and reconstruction, curb ramps reconstruction, drainage improvements, signing and pavement markings, and pedestrian lighting improvements. To provide better traffic signal control at the intersection, an Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) will be installed. Additional work includes new signal poles and a traffic separator to prevent left turns onto northbound Orange Avenue.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists should expect daytime and nighttime lane closures and detours on weekdays and weekends. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to direct traffic through the work zone. Road conditions during construction will become less apparent as the project progresses. Motorists are asked to exercise caution and reduce their speed while driving through the work zone. Due to construction, there might be some noise around the area.

The contractor will maintain pedestrian access to sidewalks during construction using signed detours, traffic control devices, and/or temporary walkways and ramps, when appropriate. The construction schedule may change due to weather, special events, and other unexpected conditions.
