### **Babcock Street (S.R. 507) Corridor Planning Study, Brevard County**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding project plans on Babcock Street (State Road (S.R.) 507) from Palm Bay Road to New Haven Avenue (U.S. 192) on Tuesday, May 18, at 5:30 p.m. The purpose of this project is to evaluate the current transportation operations and needs along this 3-mile section of Babcock Street. As part of this first step in the project process, potential safety and mobility enhancements as well as multimodal improvements will be studied along the corridor. Both short-term and long-term proposed improvements will be recommended from this study. The public meeting is being held to present information and receive community feedback. FDOT is offering multiple ways to participate in the meeting. All participants will receive the same information on the proposed project.
