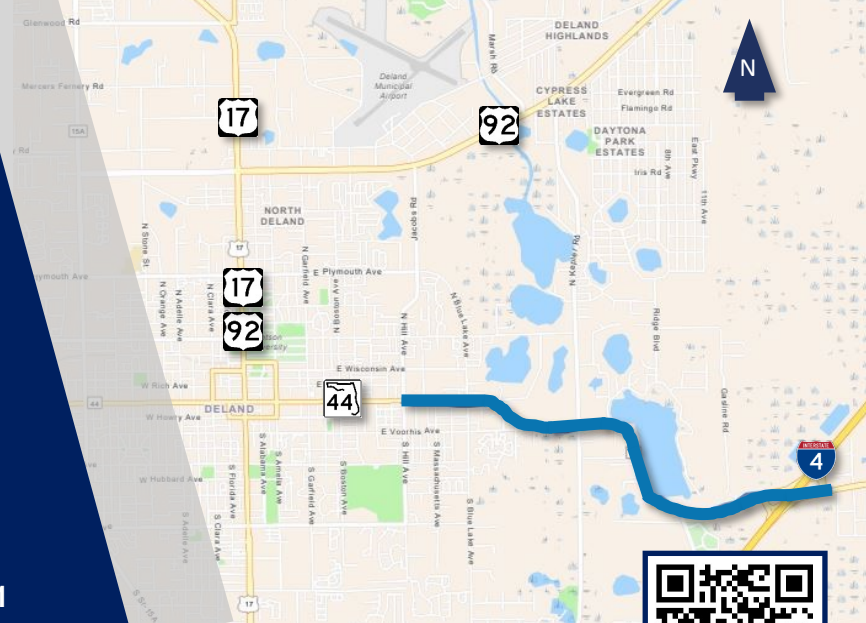




S.R. 44 Resurfacing from N. Hill Avenue to I-4 EB On Ramp

Volusia County

Project Description

This project extends nearly 3.8 miles along State Road (S.R.) 44 from North Hill Avenue to the Interstate 4 (I-4) eastbound on ramp. The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing the project to provide safety and operational improvements along the corridor.

The project will repave this segment of S.R. 44 to extend the life of the existing roadway. Pedestrian improvements are also planned, including new sidewalk, upgrading pedestrian signals, enhancing intersection lighting, and reconstructing the sidewalk curb ramps to comply with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards. Other operational improvements include drainage modifications, slope correction at two curves, and guardrail upgrades at the I-4 overpass. Bicycle lanes will be provided by pavement widening on the shoulders. The project excludes the project limits of a proposed roundabout at the intersection of S.R. 44 and Kepler Road, which is being designed under FPID number 431922-1.
