Conway Road (S.R. 15) at Simmons Road Safety Improvements, Orange County

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public hearing regarding project plans on Conway Road (State Road (S.R.) 15) at Simmons Road on Tuesday, June 29, at 5:30 p.m. The purpose of this project is to increase safety by modifying the open median to a bi-directional configuration at the intersection of Conway Road (S.R. 15) and Simmons Road in Orange County. FDOT is offering multiple ways to participate in the same live hearing.

Virtual: Join from a computer, tablet, or mobile device for free and listen to the live presentation over the internet. Advance registration at <http://fdot.cc/sr15-virtual> is required; participants will receive an email with information about joining the hearing online. Please note, Internet Explorer cannot be used to register or attend this webinar.

All safety and sanitation guidelines and local ordinances must be followed. Persons who are not feeling well should not attend the in-person hearing.

The hearing will open at 5:30 p.m., and the presentation will begin promptly at 6 p.m. If joining online, please allow adequate log-in time prior to the presentation.
