



# International Speedway Boulevard (U.S. 92) Pedestrian Improvements

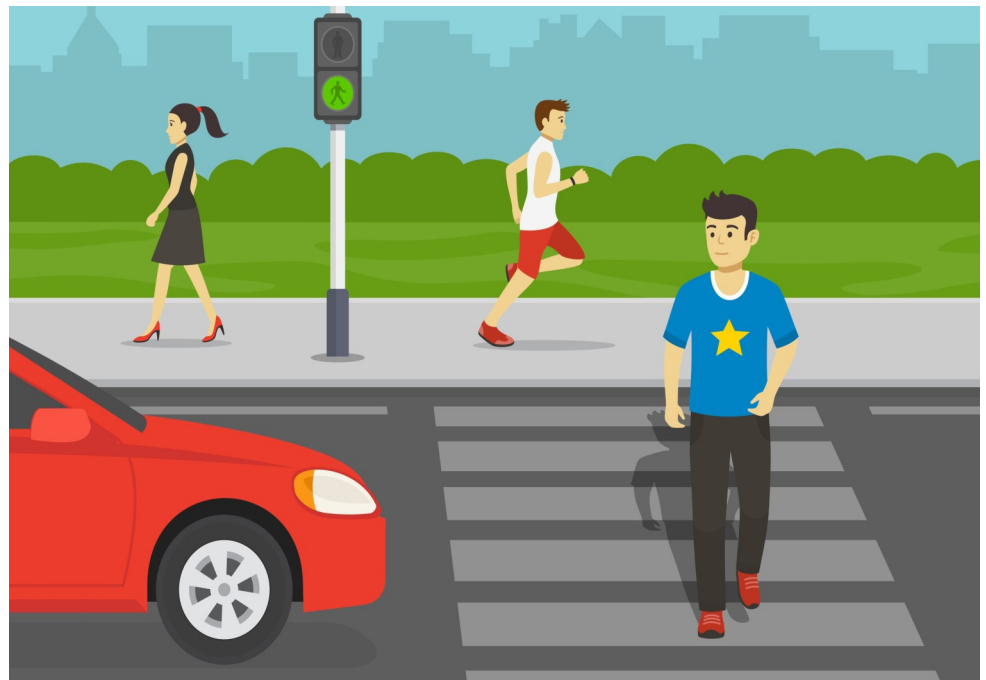

### Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is planning improvements to enhance safety for pedestrians and drivers on International Speedway Boulevard (U.S. 92) at Lockhart Street in Daytona Beach. The project proposes to construct a new traffic signal at the intersection to provide a signalized pedestrian crossing.

The signalized crossing will require construction of new signal poles, as well as curb reconstruction to accommodate pedestrian curb ramps. The project is based on a request from the FDOT District 5 Safety Office to implement the recommendations of the March 2020 Pedestrian Mid-Block Crossing Study.



Initial design for this project has been completed. The project team will review and update the plans beginning in spring 2024. The design was adjusted to eliminated the need for additional right of way.
