

RESURFACING AND PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

Woodland Boulevard (U.S. 17-92) from Wisconsin Avenue to north of Taylor Road (S.R. 15A)

Volusia County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is resurfacing Woodland Boulevard (U.S. 17-92/ State Road (S.R.) 15/600) from Wisconsin Avenue in Orange City to north of Taylor Road (S.R. 15A) in DeLand to extend the life of the roadway. Additional improvements include extending the medians to create a refuge within the crosswalk for pedestrians crossing Woodland Boulevard at Minnesota Avenue, Firehouse Road, and Orange Camp Road/McGregor Road. This project will also add 7-foot-wide marked bike lanes along both sides of Woodland Boulevard from Orange Camp Road/McGregor Road to Taylor Road, fill in sidewalk gaps from Wisconsin Avenue to Firehouse Road, and upgrade curb ramps to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

Lighting will also be added at the Woodland Boulevard intersections of Firehouse Road and Orange Camp Road, at the sidewalk crossings at the S.R. 472 ramps, and under the S.R. 472 bridge. Improvements also include drainage upgrades and new pavement markings.

WHAT TO EXPECT

At least one lane of Woodland Boulevard in both directions will remain open to vehicle traffic during the project. Motorists should expect nighttime single and double lane closures on Woodland Boulevard between the hours of 7:30 p.m. and 6:30 a.m. throughout construction. Intermittent sidewalk detours will be utilized to accommodate pedestrian traffic around the work area. Work on the S.R. 472 ramps will require occasional overnight ramp closures accompanied by a detour between the hours of 9:30 p.m. and 6 a.m.

Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to direct traffic around closures. Motorists and pedestrians are asked to exercise caution while traveling through the work zone. Access to side streets, residences, and businesses will be maintained throughout the duration of the project.

The level of work activity will vary during different phases of construction, and the schedule may change due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.
