



Woodland Boulevard (U.S. 17-92) Improvements

From Wisconsin Avenue to north
of Taylor Road (S.R. 15A)

Volusia County

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) plans to resurface Woodland Boulevard (U.S. 17-92) from Wisconsin Avenue in Orange City to north of Taylor Road (State Road (S.R.) 15A) in DeLand to extend the life of the existing roadway.

Pedestrian safety improvements include extending the medians to create a refuge for pedestrians crossing at the south side of Minnesota Avenue; the north, east and west side of Firehouse Road; and the north and south sides of Orange Camp Road/McGregor Road (see graphic below). Also, the project will add 7-foot-wide marked bike lanes from Orange Camp Road to Taylor Road and fill in sidewalk gaps from Wisconsin Avenue to Firehouse Road.

Other improvements include adding lighting at the intersections of Firehouse Road and Orange Camp Road, at the new sidewalk crossings at the S.R. 472 ramps and under the S.R. 472 bridge. Drainage improvements and updating curb ramps to Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards is also included.
