Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is conducting an areawide transportation planning study in Maitland. This comprehensive study will evaluate the existing operations and potential roadway improvements for all modes of travel such as vehicular, pedestrian, bicycle, and transit modes within the study area, focusing on the following corridors:

- U.S. 17-92 (Orlando Avenue) from just south of Maitland Avenue to Seminole County Line;
- State Road (S.R.) 414 (Maitland Boulevard) from Lake Faith Drive to the end of the U.S. 17-92 ramps; and,
- Maitland Avenue (County Road (C.R.) 427) from U.S. 17/92 to Stone Hill Drive.

The study is being conducted in partnership with the City of Maitland, Orange County, LYNX, and MetroPlan Orlando to improve multimodal safety, operations, and connectivity. The study team will engage key stakeholders and community members throughout the process to seek input in understanding the needs and desires of the corridors, as well as to collect feedback on potential solutions.
