From north of Palm Coast Parkway to south of the St. Johns County line (Pellicer Creek Bridge)

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing to resurface U.S. 1 (State Road (S.R.) 5) from north of Palm Coast Parkway to south of the St. Johns County line (Pellicer Creek Bridge) to extend the service life of the existing roadway.

Other improvements include minor drainage enhancements and signage and pavement markings along the nearly 7-mile-long corridor. The roadway configuration will remain the same throughout the project limits.

Work on this project does not include the existing roundabout intersection at West Mantanzas Woods Parkway. Work on the proposed roundabout at the Old Kings Road intersection is also not included in this project.
