The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding project plans on U.S. 1 from south of Minnie Lane to the Volusia County line on Thursday, June 22, 2023, at 5:30 p.m. The purpose of this project is to resurface this segment of U.S. 1 and make pedestrian safety and operational improvements at Anglers Lane.
