ROADWAY RESURFACING

S.R. A1A From South 8th Street to North 18th Street

Flagler County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is resurfacing State Road (S.R.) A1A from South 8th Street to North 18th Street in Flagler Beach. This project includes pedestrian safety enhancements, such as upgrading certain crosswalks with Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons (PHBs) at the following intersections on S.R. A1A:

- South 8th Street
- South 3rd Street
- North 5th Street

Additionally, pedestrian curb ramps throughout the project corridor will be upgraded to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists should expect intermittent lane closures throughout the project corridor. The speed limit in the work zone will range from 25 to 35 mph. Those accessing certain driveways along the project corridor may experience temporary impacts; the contractor will coordinate closely with affected property owners to minimize disruptions.

Electronic message boards and other signage will direct traffic through the work zone. Construction activity levels and noise will vary during different phases of the project. Please note that the construction schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather or other unforeseen conditions.
