



U.S. 192 Improvements From Bamboo Lane to Main Street

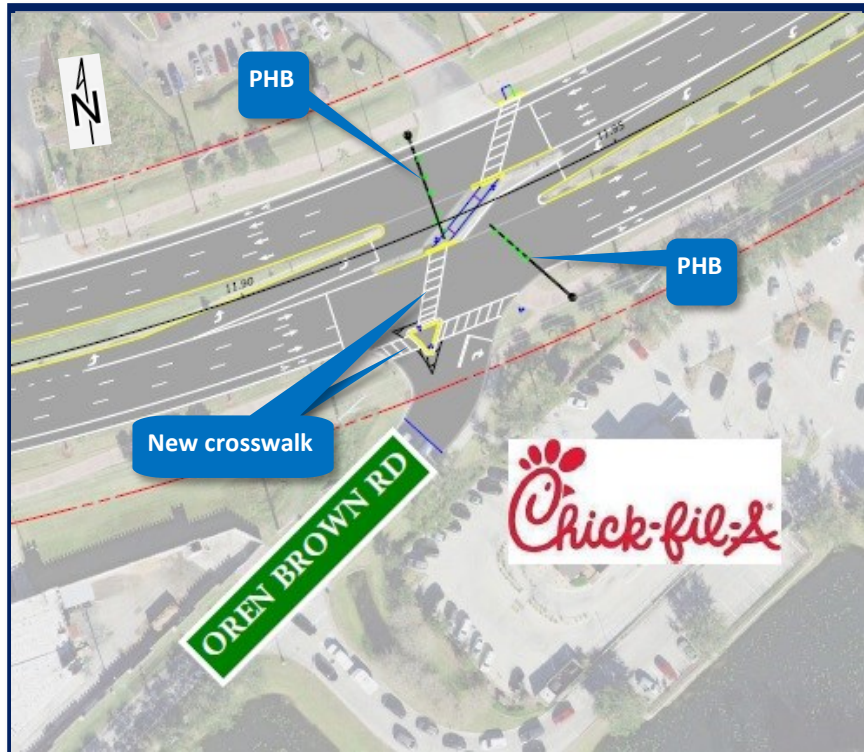


Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing safety and operational improvements on U.S. 192 from Bamboo Lane to Main Street in Kissimmee. The project plans to repave and restripe U.S. 192 to provide 11-foot-wide travel lanes and a new 7-foot-wide bicycle lane from east of Bamboo Lane to Hoagland Boulevard.

Additionally, the project would include new signalized pedestrian crossings, equipped with Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons (PHBs), at Club Sevilla, Oren Brown Road, and Rose Avenue (see side graphic). A new pedestrian mid-block crossing is proposed south of Four Winds Boulevard, and a turn lane extension and pedestrian improvements are planned at Old Vineland Road.

Other pedestrian improvements include curb ramp upgrades and new sidewalk connections at Yates Road and Mann Street. East of Hoagland Boulevard, lanes will be 11-feet-wide, and the curb line will be adjusted to accommodate a wider sidewalk.
