



U.S. 192/U.S. 441 Resurfacing

From Nova Road (C.R. 532) to Arthur J. Gallagher Boulevard

Osceola County

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing improvements on U.S. 192/U.S. 441 (East Irló Bronson Memorial Highway) from Nova Road (County Road (C.R.) 532) to Arthur J. Gallagher Boulevard in Osceola County.

The purpose of this project is to resurface the travel lanes to extend the life of the roadway and enhance safety along the corridor. Other planned improvements include:

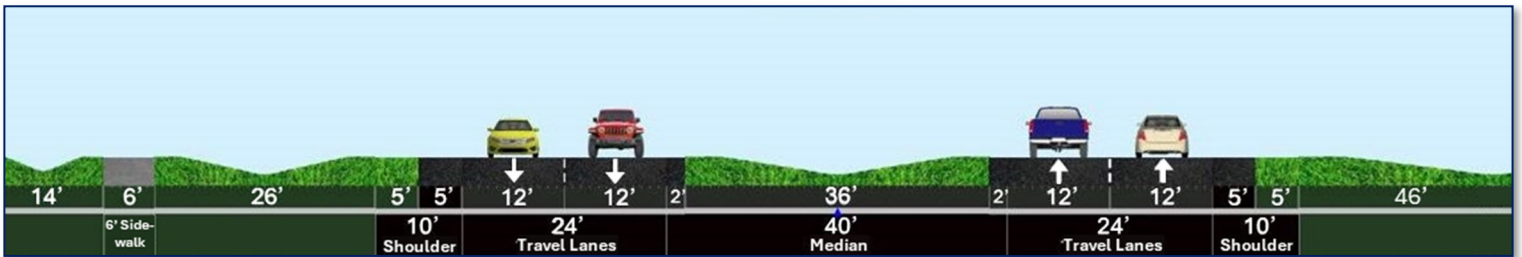
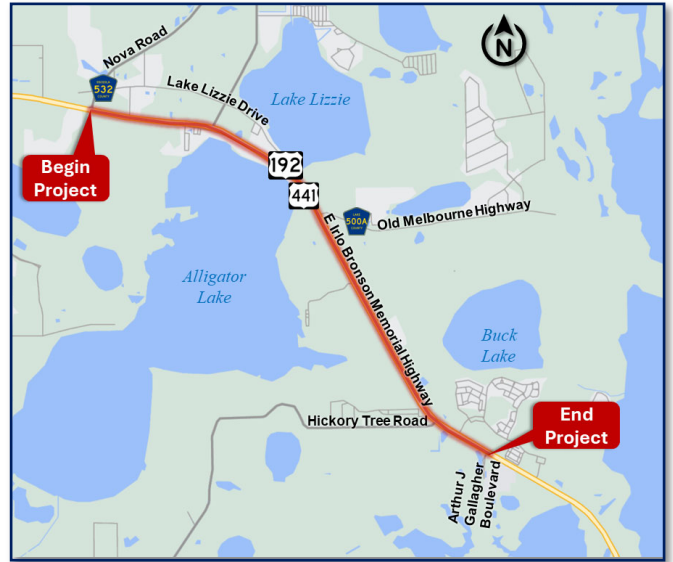
From Nova Road to Arthur J. Gallagher Boulevard

- Construct 6-foot-wide sidewalk along the westbound side of the roadway to enhance safety and mobility
- Upgrade all signs and pavement markings

At U.S. 192/U.S. 441 and Arthur J. Gallagher Boulevard

- Upgrade intersection lighting and traffic signal heads
- Install a supplemental near-side signal, which is a signal positioned closer to the intersection for improved visibility
- Add crosswalk with a pedestrian signal and detector at the west leg of the intersection

In addition to these improvements, a bicycle through lane (or keyhole lane) will be added at the Nova Road intersection, and new intersection lighting is planned at Old Melbourne Highway (C.R. 500A). Pedestrian curb ramps will be reconstructed as needed to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards. Landscaping enhancements will also be provided between Lake Lizzie Court and Lake Lizzie Drive to discourage illegal use of the right of way.
