The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding project plans on Lee Road (State Road (S.R.) 423) from west of Kingswood Drive to east of Adanson Street on Thursday, July 27, 2023, at 5:30 p.m. The purpose of this project is to promote pedestrian safety along S.R. 423, including intersection improvements and converting the existing directional median west of Adanson Street at the shopping center to a full traffic signal. FDOT is offering multiple ways to participate in the live meeting.
