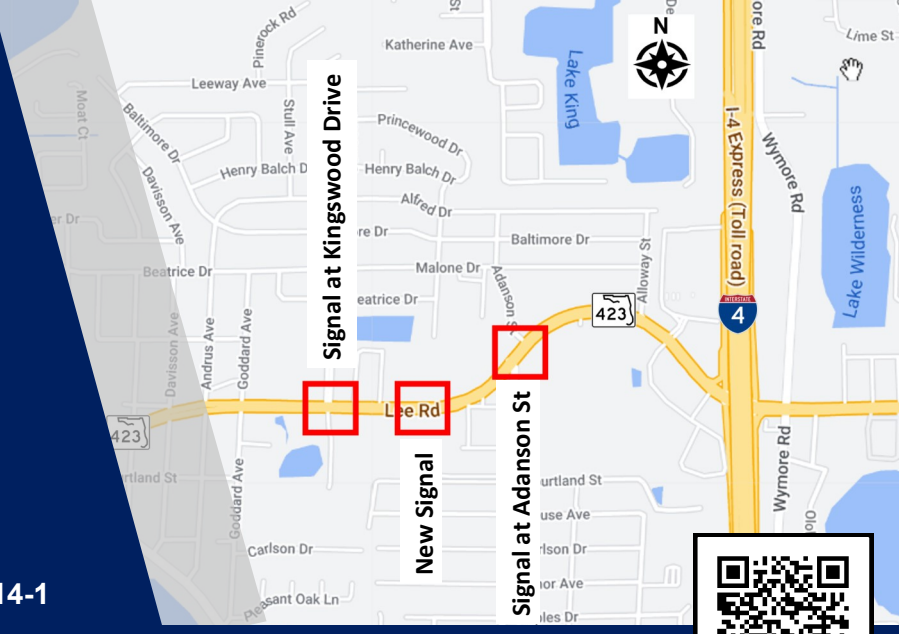




Lee Road (S.R. 423) Intersection Improvements From West of Kingswood Drive to East of Adanson Street

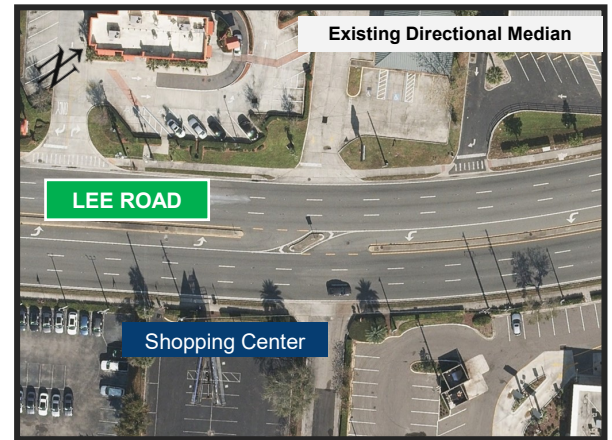
Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) proposes improvements along Lee Road (State Road (S.R.) 423) from west of Kingswood Drive to east of Adanson Street. The purpose of this project is to promote pedestrian safety through intersection improvements within the corridor.

At Kingswood Drive and Adanson Street, the project plans to reconstruct the existing traffic signals and extend the eastbound left turn lanes to ease congestion. Improved crosswalks on Lee Road and “Yield to Pedestrians” blank out signs will help improve pedestrian safety at both intersections. Lighting upgrades and necessary drainage improvements are included.

The project also proposes to convert the existing directional median just west of Adanson Street at the entrance to the shopping center to a full traffic signal.

These proposed improvements along S.R. 423 were approved based on a Pedestrian Safety Study prepared in January 2021.
