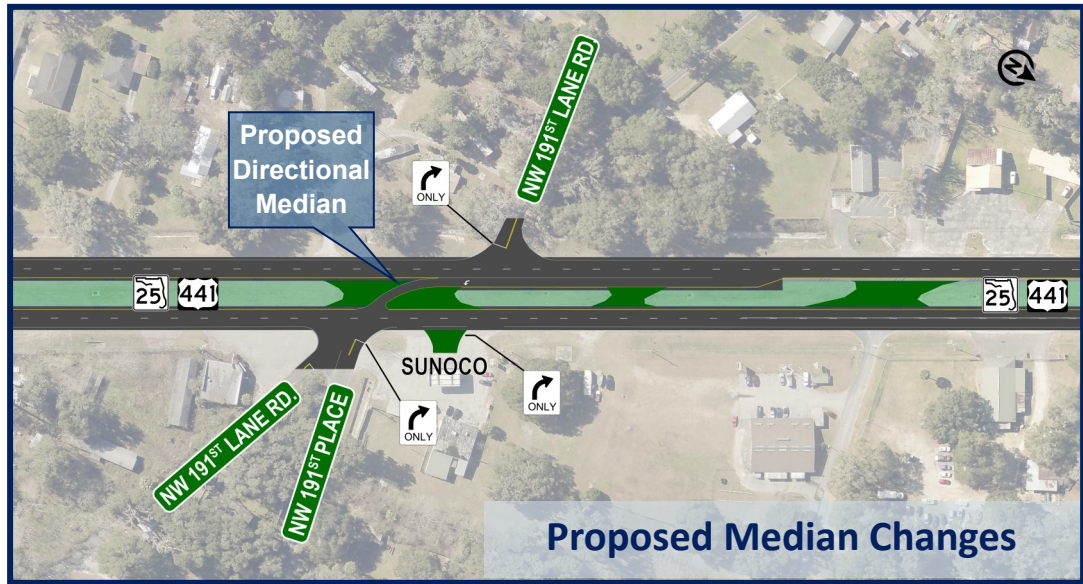

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is planning improvements along U.S. 441 (State Road (S.R.) 25) from north of County Road (C.R.) 25A to Avenue I, south of McIntosh. The purpose of the project is to improve safety and operations along the corridor. The project includes repaving this 3.1-mile segment of U.S. 441 to extend the service life of the existing roadway.

FDOT also intends to improve safety at the intersection of U.S. 441 and NW 191st Lane Road/NW 191st Place, near the Sunoco gas station. The current full median opening will be replaced with a directional median, allowing only left turns from southbound U.S. 441 onto NW 191st Lane Road/NW 191st Place. Vehicles from NW 191st Lane Road/NW 191st Place or the gas station wanting to travel southbound on U.S. 441 will be required to turn right onto northbound U.S. 441 and make a U-turn at the next median opening.



Additionally, FDOT plans to adjust the signal timing at the intersection of U.S. 441 and West Highway 318, providing separate signal phases for different traffic movements to improve safety.

This project is expected to be constructed with FPID No. 445218-1, a resurfacing project on U.S. 441 from Avenue I to the Alachua County Line (see reverse).

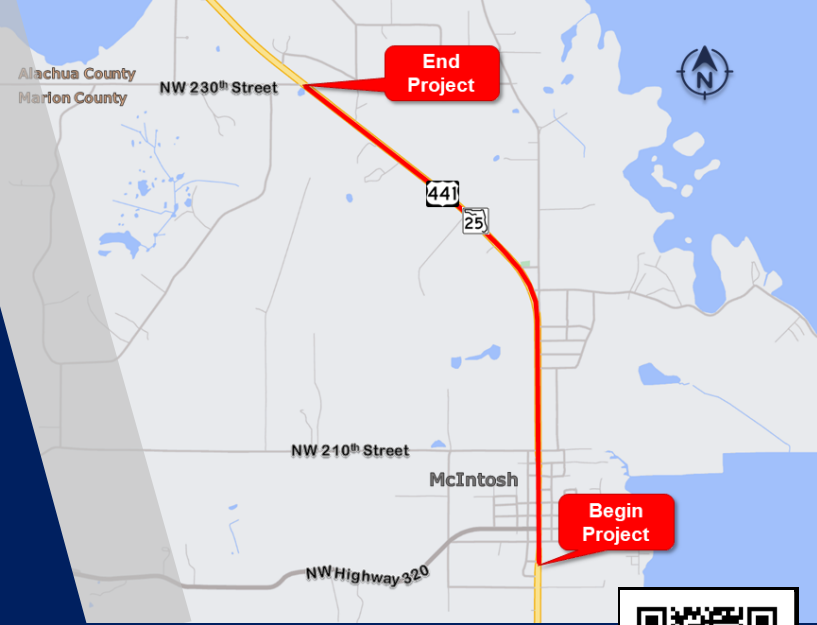

U.S. 441 (S.R. 25) Improvements From Avenue I to the Alachua County Line

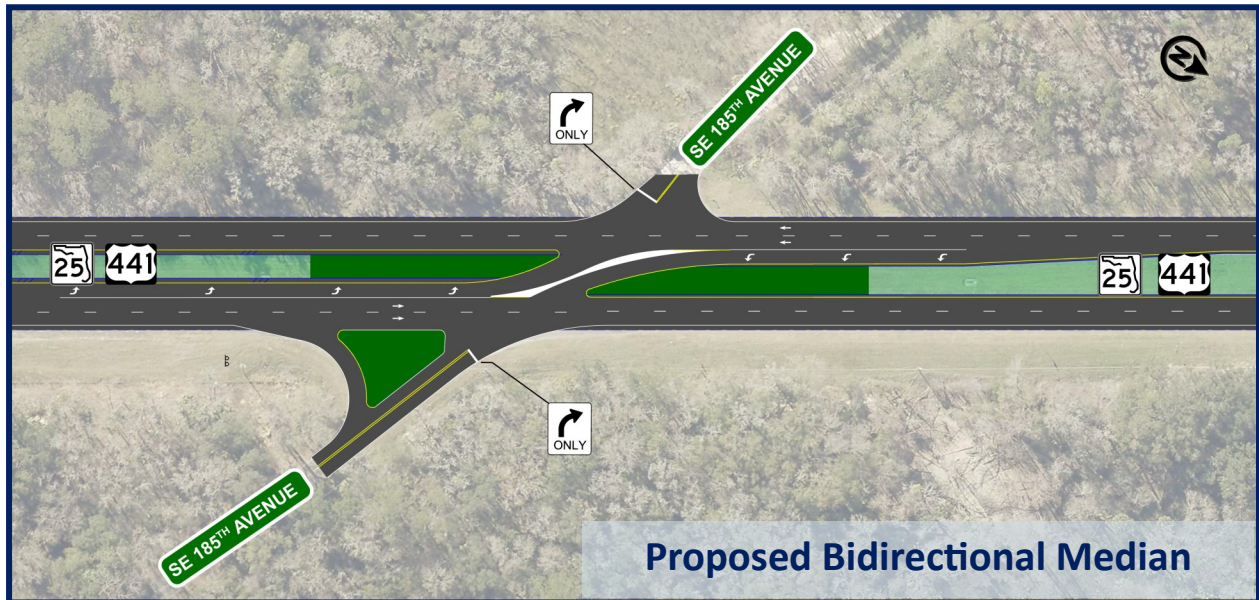


Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing improvements along U.S. 441 (State Road (S.R.) 25) from Avenue I in McIntosh to the Alachua County Line. The purpose of the project is to improve operations and safety by repaving this 3.1-mile segment of U.S. 441 to extend the life of the existing roadway.

Proposed changes in the town of McIntosh include updating the traffic signal at Avenue G, rebuilding curb ramps to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards, and minor drainage improvements.

FDOT is also proposing to convert the existing full median opening at SE 185th Avenue, near the Alachua County Line, into a bidirectional median opening. This safety improvement will prevent left turns from side streets onto U.S. 441. Roadway users will be required to turn right onto U.S. 441 and make a U-turn at nearby median openings.



This project is expected to be constructed with FPID No. 448635-1, a resurfacing project on U.S. 441 from north of County Road (C.R.) 25A to Avenue I (see reverse).
