### U.S. 41 Improvements, Marion County

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting regarding project plans on U.S. 41 (Williams Street) from north of the Citrus County line to SW 110th Street in Dunnellon on Thursday, March 2, at 5:30 p.m. The purpose of this project is to improve safety and extend the life of the existing roadway. FDOT is offering multiple ways to participate in the live meeting.
