## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is resurfacing U.S. 27 (State Road (S.R.) 25) from County Road (C.R.) 33 to Middlesex Road in Lake County to extend the life of the existing roadway.

In addition to repaying the corridor, other operational and safety enhancements include the addition of a southbound right turn lane on C.R. 25A near the Lake County Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Support Facility and the removal of the "Y intersection" to improve the connection at C.R. 25A across from Saxon Road.

The project will include drainage improvements and the construction of a sidewalk on northbound U.S. 27 from the Lakeside Apartments to the existing sidewalk north of C.R. 25A. Additional work will include shoulder treatment, curb and gutter, bike lanes, and signing and pavement markings.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT

Daytime and nighttime work is possible. During construction, motorists should expect occasional overnight lane closures and detours. Electronic message boards and other signage will direct traffic through the work zone.

Uneven pavement is a common condition with projects that require temporary asphalt or resurfacing, as the contractor must place several layers of asphalt throughout construction. Motorists should reduce speed, heed posted signage, and remain alert throughout the work zone. The construction is subject to change due to weather or unexpected circumstances.
