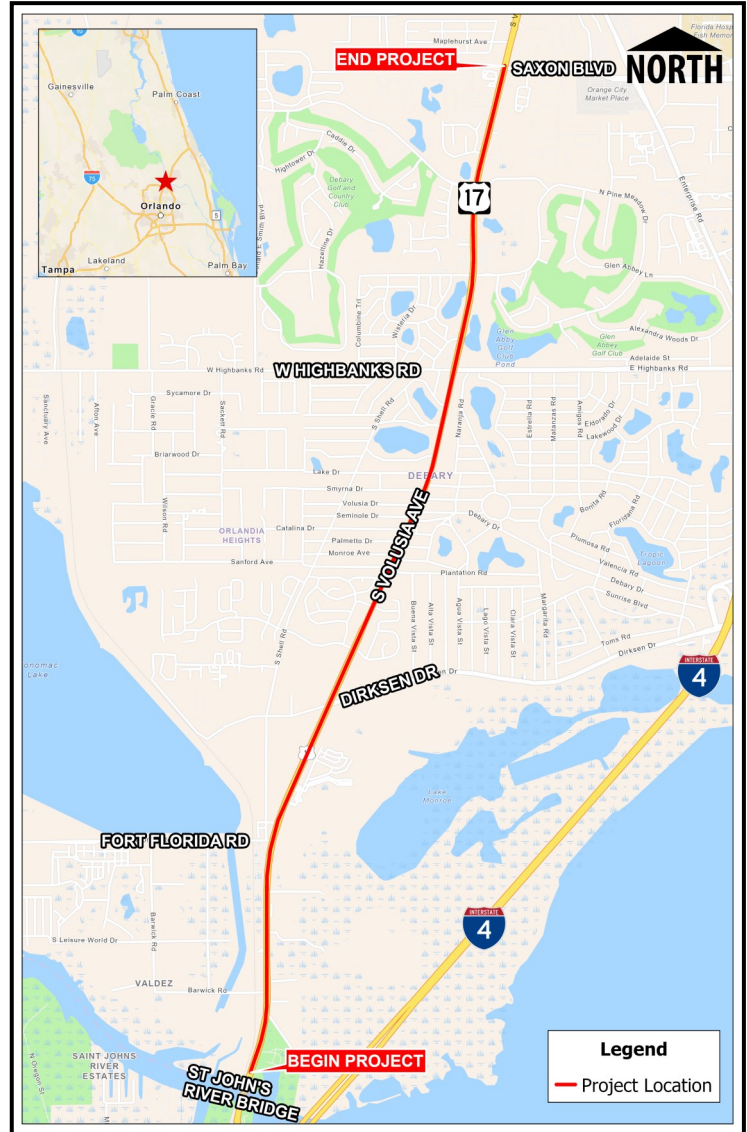


Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is designing improvements to U.S. 17-92 (State Road 15/600) from the St. Johns River bridge to north of Saxon Boulevard in Debarry. The purpose of this project is to resurface the roadway to maintain the pavement. The project will also restore all signal detection affected by resurfacing.

To enhance safety along the corridor, the project plans to reconstruct existing curb ramps and detectable warning surfaces to comply with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements. Signing and pavement marking upgrades, including high-visibility pedestrian crosswalks, are planned to enhance safety for pedestrians and drivers.

As part of the project, travel lanes will be slightly narrowed to provide wider shoulders for bicycle use along the corridor. No additional changes to the existing roadway configuration are planned.
