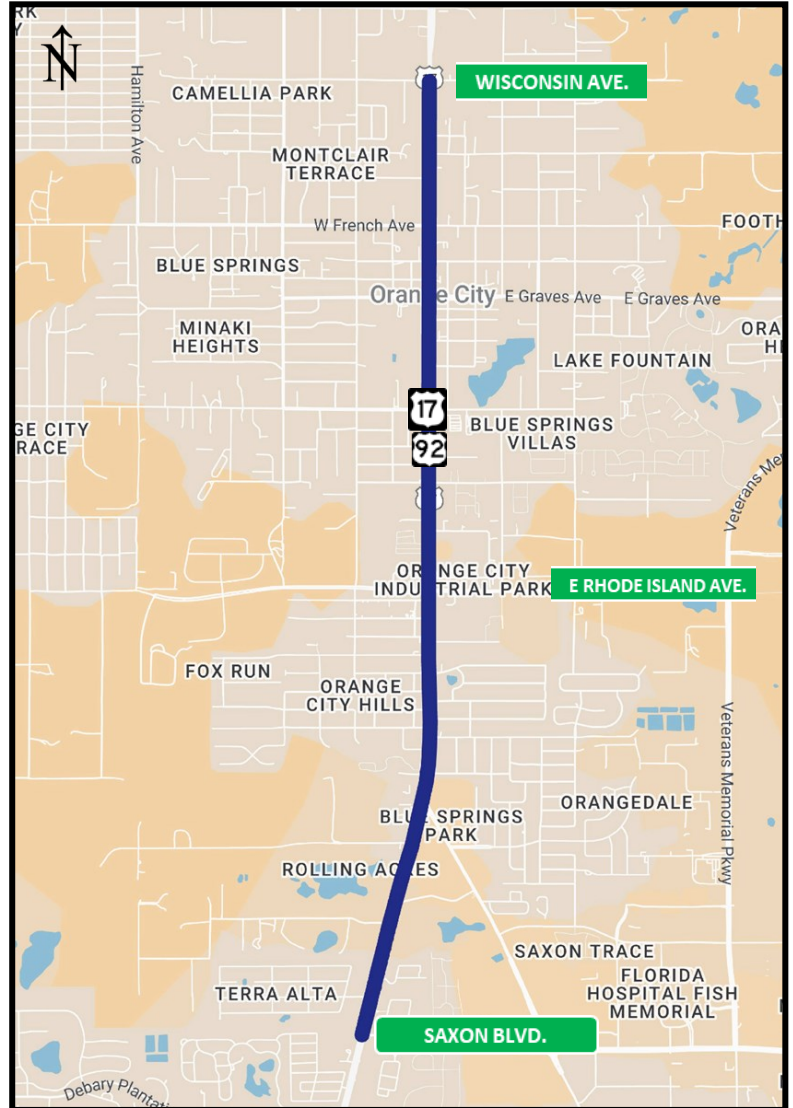
Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is designing improvements on U.S. 17-92 (State Road 15/600/South Volusia Avenue) from north of Saxon Boulevard to north of Wisconsin Avenue in Orange City.

The purpose of this project is to resurface the roadway to maintain the pavement. Traffic signal detection will also be restored.

To enhance safety along the corridor, the project will reconstruct existing curb ramps and detectable warning surfaces as needed to comply with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements.

Signing and pavement marking upgrades, including high-visibility pedestrian crosswalks, are planned.
