The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing improvements on U.S. 27 (State Road (S.R.) 25) from north of S.R. 50 to County Road (C.R.) 561A (Southern Breeze Drive/ Lake Minneola Shores) in the cities of Clermont and Minneola in southern Lake County. The total project length is approximately 2.6 miles.
