




Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is planning improvements on State Road (S.R.) 436 (East Semoran Boulevard) from U.S. 441 (South Orange Blossom Trail) to the Seminole County line in Apopka.

The purpose of this project is to resurface this segment of S.R. 436 to maintain the roadway. This project will also reconstruct pedestrian curb ramps in accordance with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards as needed.
